1. **WE EXTEND A WARM WELCOME TO OUR GUESTS TODAY.** We ask each person, member and guest alike, to sign the Friendship Pad that you find in your pew, filling out your name, address, and phone number. When the pad reaches the end of the pew, pass it back. Notice the names of people in your pew, and greet each other by name after worship.
2. **PRAYER CARDS** are available in the pew racks for any special concerns you may have. Please place them in the offering plates. Prayers for concerns will be offered by Elders and church staff after the Worship Service.

4. **DIRECTIONS TO JEAN THOMPSON'S HOME:** Going north on US 31 (National Road), after the stoplight at Home Avenue/Westenedge, turn right at the first set of stone pillars going into Forest Park. That is Hawthorne Drive or going south on US 31, after the stoplight at Washington Street, turn left at the second set of stone pillars going into Forest Park – that is Hawthorne Drive. Keep going straight; Hawthorne turns into Woodland Parkway, house is the 4th one on the left. Go to the second turnaround, head back toward the highway. The house is stone with beige trim and a green door, 3212 Woodland Parkway.
